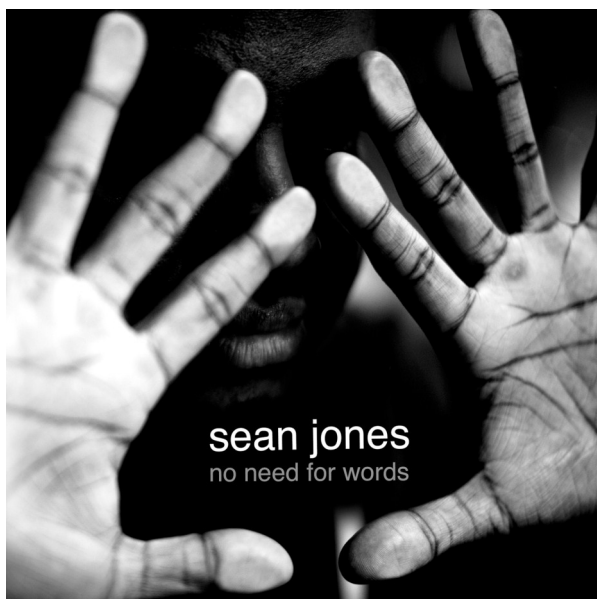

Come join Sean Jones on a journey through the composers mind. Sean will take University-level music students (whether you're into jazz, classical, or composition) on a step-by-step process through creating a song, arranging it and bringing it to life. Topics discussed will include themes, rhythmic ideas, the germ idea, and various devices used by composers. Sean will also take questions during the



workshop, and there will be an opportunity for all participants to involved in the creative process.

Sean Jones is an internationally recognized jazz trumpeter and composer/arranger. Sean held the Lead Trumpeter position in Wynton Marsalis' Jazz at Lincoln Center

Orchestra for over a decade. In 2011 Jones released his sixth CD, *No Need For Words*. This past summer, Sean toured with Herbie Hancock, Marcus Miller, and Wayne Shorter in Europe – celebrating Miles Davis' Legacy.
